RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: Resolution authorizing to acceptance of one-time funding in the amount of Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars and Seven Cents (\$9,607) from the Department of Boating and Waterways for the Boating Enforcement Financial Aid Program for fiscal year 2007-2008.

The Department of Boating and Waterways under Harbor and Navigation Code 663.7 (a) is to provide financial aid for boating safety and enforcement programs in The State of California. The contracted amount for The County of Mariposa for the fiscal year of 2007-2008 is Two Hundred Thirty One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Seven (\$231,827).

The Department of Boating and Waterways is augmenting a one-time funding in the amount of Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars and Seven Cents (\$9,607) to the County of Mariposa for the Boating and Safety Enforcement Program. The funds will be used for maintenance on the patrol boats.

The Mariposa County Sheriff's Office is responsible for boating safety and enforcement on the Merced River, Lake McClure and Lake Mc Swain. The Mariposa County Sheriff's Office has up to three deputies assigned to the boating safety and enforcement program when fully staffed. The funding received pays for the personnel costs for assigned deputies and a portion of the operation costs. The deputies are charged in with providing boating safety and enforcement to the guests that visited Lake McClure, Lake Mc Swain and the Merced River.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS: Mariposa County has been participating in the financial aid program since 1987

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION: The Mariposa County Sheriff's Office is responsible for boating safety and enforcement on the Merced River, Lake McClure and Lake Mc Swain. Failure to except funding would result in funding going to another Boating and Safety program in another county.
