RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Recommend Resolution authorizing Health Officer to apply for payment (\$6,000 over the next four years) of a Civil Consent Judgement Penalty by Pacific Bell Telephone/AT&T for purposes of hazardous materials inspection and enforcement.

Recommend the Board authorize the Health Officer to work with the Auditor, County Counsel and other County agencies to submit documentation necessary to obtain this funding.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Case # CV028367, People vs. Pacific Bell Telephone Company, dba AT&T California is being handled by the San Joaquin County Office of the District Attorney. Mariposa County Health Department, because of its role in inspecting and enforcing hazardous materials control at AT&T facilities, is eligible for up to a total of \$6,000 from this settlement but, according to the conditions of the settlement, that money will have to be deposited into a trust account and utilized only for enforcing Chapter 6.7, Division 20, Health and Safety Code.
