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RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Recommend resolution authorizing Chair to sign agreement with the Fair Agriculture Commission for the use of the building for Pandemic Flu Clinic exercise.

In order to test the Health Department's ability to respond to potential Pandemic Influenza and other county agencies' interactions and supporting that effort, the Health Department is designing an exercise to drill response to Pandemic Flu covering a three day period October 3, 4, and 5. The drill will be composed of three distinct but interrelated events:

1. Day 1 (half day) identification of challenges and brain storming solutions from the earliest stages of an Influenza Pandemic. Five key agencies will participate.
2. Day 2 (all day) exercise a virtual mass immunization clinic involving Health Department staff, volunteers, support agencies, and a large number of volunteer members of the public to pose as recipients of the vaccine. This will be held at the Fair Grounds where such a large-scale clinic would be held on the south side of the county.
3. Day 3 (half day) brain storming among involved agencies regarding hospital and health care providers' response to a severe increases in cases (Surge capacity testing) and the roles of the support agencies in obtaining resources if needed and providing ancillary services including support of social health needs, mental health needs, school system, ambulance service, and IT capacity.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

With the board's approval, the Health Department will extend invitations to effected agencies and move into the phase of detailed planning.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The Health Department Pandemic Flu plan will remain untested.
