Recommendation

It is respectfully requested that your Board: (1) approve a Behavioral Health contract for psychiatric inpatient services with Stanislaus County's Behavioral Health Center; and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

Background/Current Situation

The County does not operate inpatient, residential facilities and therefore contracts for such placement. Multiple contracts are necessary as beds are in short supply throughout California. If we were to limit the number of contracts, there would almost certainly be a time that someone was in danger to themselves or others, and no bed space would be available.

Financial

This contract will continue to be paid within the Mental Health budget unit 0402. The cost will not exceed the daily rate of \$952.86, per client. There is no impact on the general fund dollars.
