RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize Chief Probation Officer to apply for the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants Program Set-Aside Funding.

Mariposa County has been identified as one of 28 California counties eligible to share Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) monies which have been set aside by the federal government. The monies must be spent by November 30, 2006 on programs that fall into one of 16 federally designated program purpose areas. This is a one time expenditure. The application must be submitted by March 17, 2006. The funding opportunity also requires a 10% match. The California Corrections Standards Authority has noted that existing programs may be augmented as well as qualifying for the 10% match. The amount set aside for Mariposa County is \$35,275 with a match of \$3,919 for a total of \$39,194 to be used in the program area.
