RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Waive First Reading and Introduce Ordinance () Waive Second Reading and Adopt Ordinance Approving Minor County Boundary Change *between Mpsa & Tuolumne Co.*

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On November 14, 2006 the Mariposa county Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the proposal to amend the common Boundary Line between Mariposa County and Tuolumne County situated in portions of Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian, Mariposa County, State of California. Direction was given to staff to return with an Ordinance to amend the common Boundary Line between Mariposa County and Tuolumne County situated in portions of Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian, Mariposa County, State of California

On October 3, 2006 the Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution setting a date, time and place of hearing for the proposed Mariposa County/Tuolumne County Boundary Line amendment.

Mariposa County Code Section 16.20.030, subsection B requires that no lot shall be divided by a county, city, or school district boundary line. South Shore Club subdivision No. 12/07/87 has been approved, including the County Boundary Line amendment. The Mariposa County Board of Supervisors previously approved a similar amendment by Resolution No. 97-341.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If the proposed Boundary Line amendment is not approved, the project applicants would be required to revise the configuration of the subdivision lots to conform to Mariposa County Code requirements.

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1031
Not to be Codified

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING MINOR COUNTY BOUNDARY CHANGE

WHEREAS, on July 12, 1988, the Mariposa County Planning Commission approved a tentative map for the South Shore Ranch project, located in Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Township 3 South, Ranch 14 East and portions of Sections 7 and 18, Township 3 South, Ranch 15 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (the “**Tentative Map**”); and

WHEREAS, through successive actions by the County and others, the life of the Tentative Map was extended through and including December 12, 2008, as validated by an order issued by the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of Mariposa on March 29, 2006, in Superior Court Case No. 8886; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the land reflected in the Tentative Map asked the Counties of Mariposa and Tuolumne to adjust the boundary line which separates those counties to conform to that map in order to satisfy condition number 10 imposed upon tentative subdivision map 87T-106 by the County of Tuolumne which prohibits the creation of any lot which is divided by a county boundary line; and

WHEREAS, both Counties have tentatively agreed to the proposed boundary line adjustment subject to compliance with California Government Code Sections, 23200 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tuolumne County on May 9, 2006, adopted a resolution initiating proceedings prescribed in the Government Code to effect the proposed boundary change and designating the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County as the agency responsible for conducting those proceedings; and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on October 3, 2006, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County set 10:00 a.m. on November 14, 2006, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 5100 Bullion Street, Mariposa, California, as the time and place for a public hearing to receive protests against the proposed boundary change; and

WHEREAS, notice of the protest hearing was published and mailed in the manner prescribed by California Government Code section 23207; and

WHEREAS, the territory affected by the proposed minor boundary change is uninhabited, as that term is defined in Government Code section 23201; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County determined that protests to the proposed boundary change were not filed by more than 50% of the property owners owning more than 50% of the value of the

land and improvements in the territory affected thereby, and that no protest was filed by the Board of Supervisors of either affected county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I

The minor boundary change, realigning the boundary between Tuolumne and Mariposa Counties adjacent to the South Shore subdivision to the location described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, fully conforms to the requirements set forth in California Government Code section 23202 and is hereby approved.

SECTION II

Inasmuch as the affected territory is uninhabited and contains no significant improvements, there shall be no division of any county debt or county-owned property within the affected territory. Property taxes and assessments shall be pro-rated, and the affected assessors parcels shall be adjusted to conform to the new boundary line as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION III


The Clerk to the Board is directed to file on or before December 1, 2007, with the State Board of Equalization and the assessors of each affected county, a statement setting forth the legal description of the boundary as changed, together with a map or plat identifying that boundary. The Clerk also shall provide copies of that statement forthwith to the County Superintendent of Schools of each affected county, the auditor of each affected county, the governing body of each special district whose boundaries include all or any part of the affected territory, and to the Clerk of the California Appellate Court and each Superior Court having jurisdiction over all or any part of the affected territory.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final passage, to wit: January 11, 2007 pursuant to California Government Code section 25123.



- 48) South 64°50'47" East 232.02 feet to a ¼ inch iron rod tagged L.S. 3031, having coordinates of Northing 2,069,983.90 and Easting 6,598,916.80, said iron rod marking the intersection of the east line of Section 13, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, M.D.M, with the Mariposa – Tuolumne County line as shown on map filed in Volume 10 of Record of Surveys at page 74, Tuolumne County Records and the end of this description.

All coordinates, bearings and distances herein are based on the California Coordinate System 1983(92) Zone 3. Multiply the distances by 1.00011308 to obtain ground level distances.

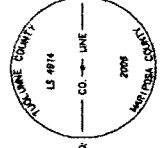
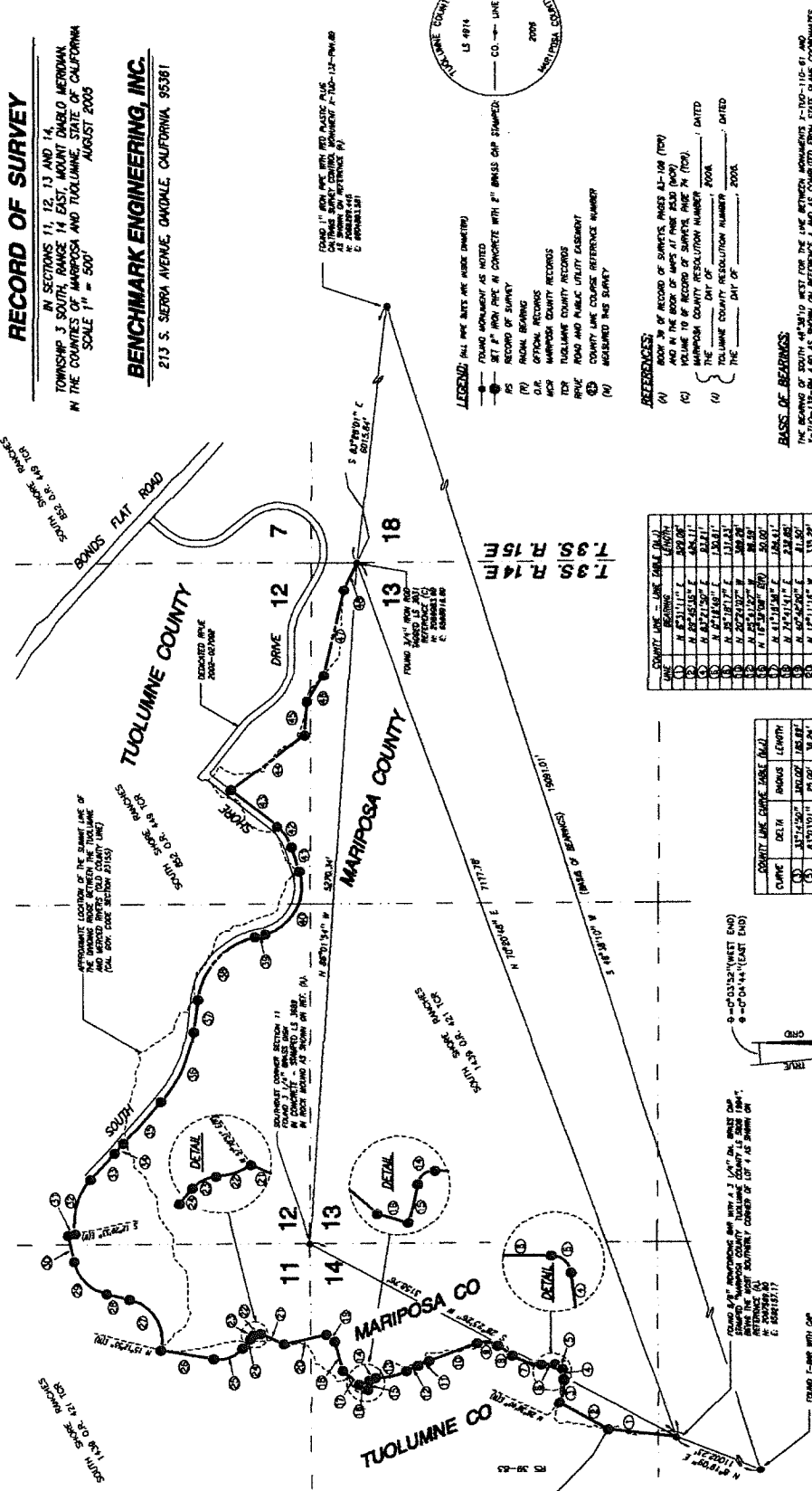

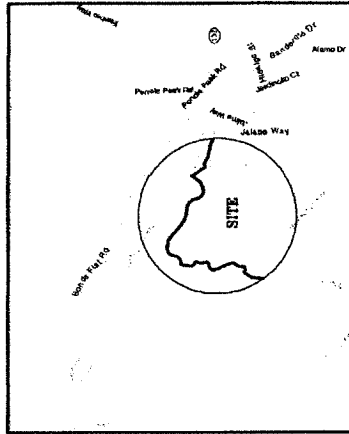
