

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 641

2 AMENDING TITLE 8, HEALTH AND SAFETY,
3 BY ADDING CHAPTER 8.40 ENTITLED
4 "UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES"

5 THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, a
6 political subdivision of the State of California does ordain
7 as follows:

8 SECTION I: Chapter 8, of the Mariposa County Code entitled
9 "Health and Safety" is hereby amended by adding Chapter 8.40,
10 entitled "Underground Storage of Hazardous Substances", to
11 provide for the County's assumption of responsibility relating
12 to inspection and permitting of underground tanks used for
13 the storage of hazardous substances. Chapter 8.40 shall read
14 in its entirety as follows:

20 8.40.010 Implementation of chapter.
21 8.40.020 Enforcement procedures.

22 8.40.010 Implementation of chapter.

23 A. The County of Mariposa hereby assumes respon-
24 sibility for the implementation of Chapter 6.7, of
25 Division 20, of the California Health and Safety Code,
26 relating to storage of hazardous substances in under-
27 ground tanks in accordance with Sections 25282 and 25288
28 of the Health and Safety Code.

B. Sections 25284 and 25284.1 of the Health and
Safety Code are hereby adopted by reference.

29 8.40.020 Enforcement procedures.

A. The Mariposa County Health Department is
hereby designated as the enforcement body of the County
and shall comply with the notice and consultation


1 provisions of Section 25282 of the Health and Safety
Code.

2 B. The Mariposa County Health Department shall
3 enforce the provisions contained in Chapter 6.7, of
4 Division 20, of the Health and Safety Code at such time
as the enforcement guidelines are presented to County
by the State of California."


5 SECTION II: This Ordinance has been deemed an urgency ordinance
6 by the Mariposa County Health Department relative to adopting procedures
7 to implement State guidelines as presented to the County by the State of
8 California, which must be in place by July 1, 1985. Therefore,
9 this Ordinance shall be passed as an urgency ordinance and
10 become effective immediately upon passage by a four-fifth vote
11 of the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Government Code Section
12 25123(d).


