

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 268
RELATING TO HAIR NETS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State
of California, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Section 51 of Ordinance Number 268, "Mariposa
Restaurant Ordinance", is amended to read as follows:

"All owners, operators and employees while engaged in the
preparation or serving of food in a public eating place shall wear
clean outer garments, shall keep their hands clean, and shall not
expectorate or use tobacco in any form while so engaged.

Every operator, male or female, whose hair is four inches
long or longer, or extends to, or beyond, the collar, or covers
the eyes, must wear a hairnet, cap or other hair coverings which
effectively confine the hair."


