WHEREAS, she joined the Hornitos Patrons Club in 1951 and has volunteered many long hours since 1951; and


WHEREAS, she has been a member of the United Methodist Women of Mariposa for many years and has volunteered at the Senior High School Graduating Class Brunch since 1952; and



WHEREAS, she rides the bus from Hornitos to Mariposa every week to serve as a volunteer at the Mariposa Activities Center Congregate Meals Program.


