RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes __ No X)

Public Works recommends a resolution approving additional County transportation permit conditions. The additional conditions (Attachment #1) are necessary to attempt to alleviate damage to public and private property by extra-legal loads hauled or towed on County-maintained roads.

When transportation permits are issued, these conditions, along with attachments describing pilot car requirements and bridge capacity limits, are given out and made a part of the permit. The hauler is then responsible for making sure all conditions are adhered to.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On May 14, 1996, the Board directed Public Works staff to return with conditions to be attached to transportation permits that would help curtail future damage to public and private property.

The following conditions are in addition to the permit conditions set forth in the Caltrans Transportation Permit manual:

1. The owner/operator of the transport company to which the transportation permit was issued, is responsible for any and all damages to either public or private properties that may be obtained in movement of the mobile home on County maintained roads.
2. The owner/operator must familiarize himself/herself with the route to be utilized to transport the mobile home. That may include driving the route to the destination of the unit prior to transporting same, as necessary.
3. If, in the course of the movement of the mobile home, the unit is unable to negotiate the County road as it exists without altering the vegetation or having to leave the road surface and enter onto private property, the transporter must first have proof, in writing, of the property owners permission to do so.

Failure to comply with the above regulations may result in the loss of privileges in being able to obtain future permits to operate within Mariposa County.

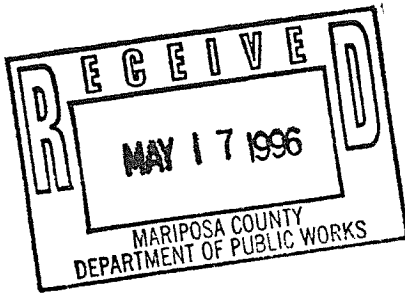
