BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On August 12, 1996, the OCJP Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution (SRVP) application for funding (\$50,000) was submitted without a Resolution of the Governing Board, because of the immediate response required in order to comply with the application deadline. On September 12, 1996, I received notification from OCJP that said application was approved in the amount of \$50,000. This funding program does not require a match in funding.

Therefore, I respectfully submit this request for ratification for the submission of said funding application and the adoption of the attached Resolution of the Governing Board, authorizing the District Attorney to execute the SRVP Grant Award Agreement.
