RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes____ No_ \times _)

Public Works recommends a resolution approving and authorizing the County Administrative Officer (CAO) to sign a letter to the California Integrated Waste Management Board authorizing the Regional Council of Rural Counties (RCRC) Environmental Services Joint Powers Authority (JPA) to apply for a Local Government Used Oil Opportunity Grant on behalf of Mariposa County.

The JPA will be authorized and empowered to execute all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments thereto for purpose of securing grant funds. The Grant application will be for a total of \$300,000 and, if approved, will be divided among the JPA members.

Staff estimates that Mariposa County will receive approximately \$10,000. The funds will be used to establish a used oil recycling facility in Greeley Hill as well as provide educational material on the recycling of used motor oil.

By participating in this grant request through the JPA, Mariposa County will not have to use staff time to apply for the grant and complete all of the paperwork associated. We will be able to purchase the oil recycling tank at a lesser price due to volume buying.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board approved membership in the Solid Waste JPA in February 1994 (Resolution #94-35). (The title of JPA was recently changed from "Solid Waste" to "Environmental Services".) Article 15 of the JPA Agreement provided for this type of service.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

- 1) Do not authorize the CAO to sign the letter to the CIWMB and relinquish any grant fund opportunities through the JPA.
- 2) Direct staff to apply for a separate grant on behalf of Mariposa County with the attendant paperwork and in efficiencies.
