A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THOSE CITIZENS WHOSE  
VOLUNTEER AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRIBUTE TO THE  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEM IN MARIPOSA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the members of emergency medical services teams devote their lives to saving the lives of others; and

WHEREAS, emergency medical services teams consist of emergency physicians, nurses, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, volunteer first responders, educators, and administrators; and

WHEREAS, the people of Mariposa County benefit daily from the knowledge and skill of these trained individuals;  
and

WHEREAS, the professional organizations of providers of emergency medical services promote research to improve and adapt their skills as new methods of emergency treatment are developed; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services teams;
