That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution approving a Personal Services Agreement with Jane Siebeneicher for the provision of Independent Living Skills Training to teenage children in Foster Care preparing them for transitioning to independent adult life.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

This Independent Living Skills program is a 100% Federally funded program that has been successful in helping teens in Foster Care approaching adult status (18 years) gain basic skills such as money management, career development and household planning.

The Board has approved contracts with Jane Siebeneicher the past 5 years to develop and provide direct services to children in the program and she has done an excellent job.

BOARD ACTION: Supervisor Stewart pulled Consent Item 7. (M) Balmain, (S) Stewart, balance of items were approved/Ayes: Reilly, Balmain, Stewart and Parker; Excused: Taber. Chairman Parker indicated that item 7 will be continued for further discussion during today's meeting.

2:28 p.m. Discussion of continuing Consent Item 7 pulled by Supervisor Stewart, earlier in meeting, to July 11, 1995, and preparing an Amended Agenda for the 11th. Board concurred with discussing item at the present time. County Administrative Officer explained personal services agreement with Jane Siebeneicher for the Human Services Department Independent Living Program, as Tom Archer, Human Services Director, was unavailable. Services provided through this contract help in preparing children leaving the foster care setting with the skills and knowledge needed to succeed in today's society. Supervisor Stewart expressed his concerns with the social ills of today and governmental funding which actually enables the breakdown of the family unit but that he recognized this as a small program.
