The Mariposa County "Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) 2017-2020 Three-Year Plan" will be reviewed during this meeting. The Board of Supervisors meets at the Mariposa County Government Center at 5100 Bullion Street in Mariposa.

Mariposa County Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (MCBHRS) invites any and all interested persons to attend and review the proposed "Mariposa County Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) 2017-2020 Three-Year Plan" and to make comments or suggestions.

This three-year MHSA Plan is part of the ongoing Mental Health Services Act funding process.
