2 RESOLUTION NO. 89-11

3 A RESOLUTION APPROVING AGRICULTURAL PRESERVE
4 APPLICATION NO. 88-3, VERNON MOYE, APPLICANT

5 WHEREAS, Agricultural Preserve Application No. 88-3 was
6 submitted in accordance with the requirements of County Code and
7 Policy; and

8 WHEREAS, this Board, by Resolution Nos. 77-157 and 78-8,
9 enacted the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 (Williamson
10 Act); and

11 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has reviewed the
12 application and held a public hearing in accordance with County
13 Code and State Law; and

14 WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed and considered the
15 recommendation of the Planning Commission.

16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board
17 of Supervisors does hereby approve Agricultural Preserve
18 Application No. 88-3 based upon the following findings:

19 1) The project complies with the provisions of the County
20 Agricultural Preserve Policy and the California Land
21 Conservation Act of 1965.

22 2) It can be demonstrated that the subject lands constitute
23 a viable agricultural production unit of not less than 160 acres
24 because of the lands historic grazing use and the lands are used
25 in conjunction with other operations in the area.

26 3) It is in the public interest to include the subject
27 lands in an agricultural preserve because of the open space

1 value of the lands.

2 4) The project is consistent with the provisions of Section
3 6.402 of the Mariposa County General Plan.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does
5 hereby adopt the attached amendment to the "Mariposa County
6 Agricultural Preserve Map" originally adopted by Resolution
7 No. 78-16 which shows those areas identified as Agricultural
8 Preserves in the County as amended.


