

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 89-78

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors has passed Resolution No. 88-569 declaring its intent to vacate a portion of Forest Road (County Road 17); and

WHEREAS, public hearing has been held to hear all persons interested in the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Forest Service has proposed a transfer of road segments to Mariposa County in exchange for that portion of Forest Road, when abandoned;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the County not proceed with the proposed vacation of Forest Road; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County will not proceed with the proposed agreement between U. S. Forest Service and Mariposa County for the exchange of roads.
