A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LEGISLATION FOR RURAL HOSPITALS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to members of the Assembly Health Committee, County Supervisors Association of California, Regional Council of Rural Counties, John C. Fremont Hospital, and Assemblymen Statham, Jones, Hauser and Waters.
