

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 89-267

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SB 1249 (DOOLITTLE)

WHEREAS, State and Federal governmental agencies frequently acquire vast acreages of land for single purpose uses; and

WHEREAS, these acquisitions are often approved without consideration of the economic and environmental consequences to the affected local community and adjacent landowners; and

WHEREAS, the protection of private property rights affects County government, the local economy, landowners and livestock producers; and

WHEREAS, Senator Doolittle has introduced SB 1249, which will provide for local governments to be notified of impending land acquisitions and the purpose for such acquisitions, establish public hearings to assure the input of area residents, establish local advisory committees for input on property management, and provide for payment to the counties of amounts equivalent to property taxes on the land acquired;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, supports SB 1249 (Doolittle) and urges the Legislature to pass it into law.
