RE: Authorize to Advertise and Award for the Repair of the El Portal Pool

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize the Public Works Director to Advertise, Solicit Bids, Award and Sign an Agreement to the Lowest Responsible Bidder for Repair of the El Portal Pool (Subject to Approval as to Form by County Counsel).

The pool is in need of repair due to deterioration of the plaster and tile inside the pool and around the surrounding area. The El Portal Pool serves an important purpose in that it provides a safe recreation destination for local residents in proximity to the Merced River.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On January 16, 2018 the Public Works Director asked the Board of Supervisors for direction after discussion regarding the condition of the El Portal Pool.

Staff received direction at the January Board of Supervisors meeting to seek external sources of funding by writing to the NPS and various other entities whose employees use this facility to see if a partnership could be developed that would fund these repairs. Staff has inquired of these Partners but have not as yet receives any response. During the mid-year Budget process funding was allocated for this project.

At the end of the 2017 swimming season staff was performing routine winter pool maintenance and noticed significant surface deterioration of the pool. Further determination of the degradation of the pool surface was determined when the pool water was drained entirely.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve, the necessary repairs will not be made and the pool will not be able to open for the residents in the area during the 2018 summer season.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT:

None, Funding was allocated during the Mid-Year Budget Process.
