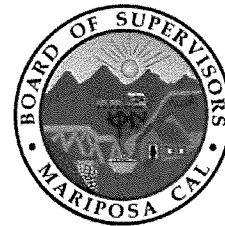

RE: Recognize Federal and State Revenue for 2017 Storm Projects and Appropriate Expenditures (\$653,991)

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### RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve budget action recognizing Federal and State Revenue for 2017 Storm Projects and Appropriate Expenditures (\$653,991). This request is based on obligation letters received to date for February 2017 storms.

### BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board routinely recognizes federal and state financial commitments made as result of emergency declarations.

### ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Negative action would prevent the County from going forward with emergency construction repair projects from February 2017 storm damage.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

**The only Financial Impact is the Local Share portion of these Emergency Repair Projects. These are all February 2017 Storm Emergency Projects and the local share is 6.25%**
