

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 83-54

2 RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

4 WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution No. 1 has been introduced by Senator
5 Ray Johnson to memorialize the President and the Congress to amend the Social
6 Security Act to allow personal information concerning applicants and recipi-
7 ents under federally funded public assistance programs to be used or disclosed
8 by the states pursuant to the administration of any governmental program, or
9 pursuant to any investigaion, prosecution, or criminal or civil proceeding
10 to which the state is a party or could be joined as a party.

11 WHEREAS, in the administration of federally funded public assistance pro-
12 grams by the states, including the State of California, personal information
13 is secured concerning applicants and recipients under these programs; and,

14 WHEREAS, the Federal Social Security Act and related administratave re-
15 gulations limit the use and disclosure of this information by the states to
16 specified purposes relating exclusively to the administration of public
17 assistance programs; and,

18 WHEREAS, these restrictions prevent the states from using this informa-
19 tion in their efforts to enforce the law and protect the public welfare in
20 various criminal and civil contexts not directly related to the administration
21 of public assistance programs.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County
23 of Mariposa that the Legislature of the State of California be encouraged and
24 requested to pass said Resolution; and


25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
