

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 83-76

2 WHEREAS, Ord. 526 of the County of Mariposa empowered
3 the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence
4 or threatened existence of a local emergency when Mariposa County
5 is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and,

6 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has been requested
7 by the Director of Emergency Services of Mariposa County to proclaim
8 the existence of a local emergency herein; and,

9 WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors does hereby find:

10 That conditions of extreme peril to the safety
11 of persons and property have arisen within Mariposa County
12 caused by wind, rain, and flooding; and

13 That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril
14 warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the
15 existence of a local emergency.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local
17 emergency now exists throughout Mariposa County; and

18 IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the
19 existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and
20 duties of the Director of Emergency Services and the
21 emergency organization of the County shall be those prescribed
22 by state law, by ordinances, and resolutions of this County
23 approved by the Board of Supervisors.

24 WHEREAS, it has now been found that local resources
25 are unable to cope with the effects of such emergency.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED
27 that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Governor
28 of California with the request that he proclaim the County of

1 Mariposa to be in a state of emergency, and further that the
2 Governor request a Presidential Declaration.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this resolution
4 be forwarded to the State Director of the Office of Emergency
5 Services.

6 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that ERIC J. ERICKSON,
7 DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES , is designated as the Local
8 Hazard Mitigation Coordinator of the County of Mariposa for the
9 purpose of assessing damage within said County and consulting
10 with Federal/State survey teams about hazard mitigation actions;

11 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that ERIC J. ERICKSON
12 DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES is hereby designated as the
13 authorized representative for public assistance of the County of
14 Mariposa for the purpose of receipt, processing, and coordination
15 of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain available
16 State and Federal Assistance.
