

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 83-338

2 A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING
3 NOVEMBER 20-26, 1983 AS FAMILY WEEK

4 WHEREAS, Families are the foundation of all successful and enduring
5 societies; and

6 WHEREAS, Families nurture the children who are society's hope for
7 continuing beyond the present generation; and

8 WHEREAS, Our nation and the State of California attained domestic
9 tranquility through the enduring, patient, valiant efforts of families who
10 homesteaded the primitive lands and transformed the wilderness into productive
11 farms, and who generated industry and commerce unmatched in the entire world;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, It has truly been noted that strong families make a strong
14 America; and

15 WHEREAS, More than a decade ago the President of the United States
16 began annually to declare the week including Thanksgiving Day as "National
17 Family Week" and this year Congress has HJR 69 before it to request the
18 President to declare National Family Week for 1983; and

19 WHEREAS, California was one of the first states to begin annually
20 declaring Thanksgiving week as "Family Week"; and

21 WHEREAS, It is most fitting and proper that the family unit be
22 acknowledged, encouraged, and honored as an essential and primary social
23 element, and that the importance of wholesome family living, family loyalties,
24 and bonding traditions be publicly recognized;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of
26 Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California that the
27 week beginning November 20, 1983, be proclaimed "Family Week".

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the citizens of Mariposa County observe

1 "Family Week" with all appropriate activities, ceremony, and celebration;
2 and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably prepared copy of this
4 resolution be transmitted to the Governor of California; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that suitably prepared copies of this
6 resolution be transmitted to the authors for appropriate distribution.

8 this 22nd day of November, 1983, by the following vote:


