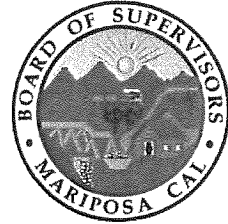

## **RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2018-517**

MEETING: November 5, 2018

TO: The Board of Supervisors

FROM: Mike Healy, Public Works Director

RE: Authorize the Public Works Director to Award Contracts from the Storm Events.

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### **RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Authorize the Public Works Director to Solicit Bids and Award Construction Contracts to initiate Permanent Infrastructure Repairs Associated with the February 2017 and March 2018 Storm Events, Subject to Approval as to Form by County Counsel.

As the Board of Supervisors is well aware, our region was the victim of tremendous storm activity during the month of February 2017 and again in March 2018 both of which caused significant damage to critical infrastructure. In many cases, the damage far exceeds the staffing availability and County owned equipment for County staff to effect repairs in a prompt and efficient manner.

The Board of Supervisors directed that repairs to restore transportation infrastructure be accomplished using private contracting resources as the amount of work far exceed the availability of internal resources.

CalOES has begun to reimburse the County for the temporary repairs accomplished both under contract and using in-house forces. CalOES has begun issuing letters of funding commitment to effect the permanent repair portion of these projects. We also expect that soon Caltrans, who administers the FHWA Program to accomplish Disaster Damage, will also begin to process funding commitment authorization letters as well.

Staff is seeking the identical authority from the Board that was granted to the Director, Public Works & Transportation with respect to the emergency repairs and that is to solicit and accept bids, award and execute agreements upon approval as to form by County Counsel. Staff seeks this authority as it is our intention to do all that we can to move as many of these projects forward toward completion prior to the challenges of the winter season.

As with the previous resolution the Director, Public Works & Transportation will routinely report to the Board the award of project contracts as they occur.

## Resolution - Action Requested 2018-517

### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

On March 28, 2017 Resolution 2017-163 the Board authorized Public Works to receive bids and award emergency contract for temporary repair work.

### **ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

Do not approve, the final restorations and repairs for these roads will not be completed.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

**The County will have a local share responsibility of 6.25% of the total cost of the work for projects funded by FEMA/CalOES. There is no County local share for FHWA. 2018 storm damage local share will be at 25%.**
