Recommendation

It is respectfully requested that your Board: (1) approve continuing a Behavioral Health contract for residential alcohol and drug treatment services with Progress House, Inc.; and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

Background/Current Situation

This County does not operate residential alcohol and drug treatment facilities and therefore contracts for such services.

Your Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board is aware of the fact that there is a need for residential treatment for those individuals who cannot stay clean and sober through utilization of groups offered in the recovery community, traditional services and Heritage House. This particular residential treatment center allows addicted women to have their children with them while in residential care. It is important that we are able to use such a facility because some women will not enter treatment and leave their children. It also reduces the need for foster care placement while a parent is becoming clean and sober. Progress House, Inc. is also a Drug Medi-Cal certified Perinatal Treatment program.

Financial

This contract will continue to be paid within the Alcohol and Drug budget unit 0403. The rates for fiscal year 2009-2010 continue to be:

Men's or Co-ed Facility	65.00/day
Women's Facility with or without children	85.00/day
Drug Testing	30.00/test
Outpatient Group	35.00/session
Outpatient Individual	75.00/session

Only those individuals who are truly committed to their own recovery, and who need a high level of care, will be offered this level of services.

There is no impact on the general fund.
