

ACTION AND VOTE:

Adopt a Resolution Authorizing the Assignment of County Vehicles as Take Home Vehicles (County Administrative Officer)

BOARD ACTION: Discussion was held with Rich Inman, County Administrative Officer. Supervisor Bibby asked for clarification relative to the recommendation for the vehicles assigned to the senior maintenance workers at Public Works. It was noted that the District Attorney wanted to discuss the recommendation for his department. (M)Parker, (S)Bibby, Res. 03-389 was adopted approving the recommendation, with the exception of the District Attorney and Public Works departments. Discussion was held. Gail Neal, Chief Probation Officer, stated she was anxious for the action to be taken for the vehicles assigned to her department. Rich Inman suggested that Exhibit "A" be amended to exclude vehicles assigned to the Public Works and District Attorney departments, and the Board concurred. Ayes: Unanimous. Direction was given to staff to bring back the portion relative to Public Works and the District Attorney with additional information.
