A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MARITA GREEN UPON HER RETIREMENT AS
DIRECTOR OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES FOR MARIPOSA COUNTY

WHEREAS, MARITA GREEN started her seventeen year career with Mariposa County in the District Attorney's Office and continued with the Family Support Division until it transitioned to a separate county agency, the Mariposa County Department of Child Support Services in July of 2001; and

WHEREAS, because MARITA always performed her duties in a manner far and above those of her job description, she was promoted from Clerk III to Family Support Officer, to Supervising Family Support Officer, to Program Manager, and then to Director of Mariposa County Child Support Services; and

WHEREAS, MARITA was appointed as the first Director of Mariposa County Child Support Services due to her total involvement in bringing the local office to the place it is today. Mariposa County Child Support Services stands in the top ten performing counties year after year due to MARITA's leadership; and

WHEREAS, MARITA has progressed through the changes in the Child Support Program when it was a small part of the District Attorney's Office to its own agency. She has seen the Office go from carbons and NCR paper to total automation with successful conversions through two child support computer systems (including being a pilot county for the first automated system in the state); and

WHEREAS, MARITA has led her staff through scenic side tours while traveling to and from the countless trainings and meetings they have attended, even establishing a "pause and think" lane on the median of a Southern California freeway; and


WHEREAS, MARITA's knowledge, compassion and easy going manner will be greatly missed by her staff as well as her ability to maintain high staff performance levels; and





Congratulating Marita Green

Mr. Speaker, I rise today to congratulate Marita Green on her seventeen years of employment with the County of Mariposa for her retirement this month. Marita began working in the District Attorney's office performing Family Support work as a Clerk III in December of 1985. Three years later, she was promoted to the position of Office Technician. She continued to serve as the Office Technician until 1991 when Marita earned the new title of Family Support Officer.

It was in 1997 when she was promoted to be the Family Support Division Manager. It was in this position she was able to use her great skills to manage the Family Support Division under the District Attorney. Four years passed and a major opportunity opened for Marita. In March of 2001, she was appointed by the Board of Supervisors as the first department head for the Child Support Services Department. Marita managed the transition from entry level support to department head elegantly and with finesse.

During Marita's time in the family support function, she has trained four different district attorneys in the family support program. She was instrumental in getting the Family Support Division fully automated. It was under her direction that the Mariposa County Family Support Program is consistently one of the top ten performing counties in the State of California.
