**ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATION LIMITS
PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CALIFORNIA
CONSTITUTION (PROPOSITION 4) AND
SB 1352 (1980 Stats. Ch. 1205)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIII B of the California State Constitution, and government Code Section 7902 and 7910 (1980 Status. Ch. 1205) Mariposa County is required to establish the appropriations limits for the 1980-81 fiscal year, and each year thereafter, for the County and each Special District thereof and


