Topic: Memorandum of Agreement with National Park Service for the Central California Conference of the Seventh Day Adventist Church Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment

The County of Mariposa and the National Park Service are co-lead agencies for the Camp Wawona Land Exchange and Facility Remodel in Wawona. To more effectively serve the applicant and people of Wawona, the Park Service and County need to execute a formal Memorandum of Agreement.

This Agreement, reviewed by County Counsel, formalizes the ongoing relationship between Mariposa Planning and the Yosemite National Park for this project.

All costs are borne by the applicant, who is aware and supports this Agreement.

The Agreement ensures the County of Mariposa maintains control over the Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment process and timelines.
