MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 611

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE TIMBER PRODUCTION ZONE

ON TIMBER PRODUCTION ZONE APPLICATION 83-1

ANNA MAE JORGENSEN, APPLICANT

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance 443 and 464 to establish the rules, regulations and standards for a Timberland Preserve Zone (TPZ) within Mariposa County; and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been held in accordance with County Ordinance and the California Government Code;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors does hereby ordain as follows:

- SECTION I: The TPZ application herein described has been reviewed and found consistent with the Mariposa County General Plan as provided for by Sections 6.502.1, 6.402.2, 6.402.5, 7.701 B and 7.702 A of the General Plan.
- SECTION II: The TPZ application herein described has been reviewed relative to Section 6.502 B.3 of the General Plan and found appropriate and necessary to preserve and protect a scenic, watershed, or wildlife habitat area which would otherwise be threatened or degraded by development.
- SECTION III: The Timber Management Plan prepared for the property indicates that the property meets the Timber Stocking Standards set forth in County Code and State law.
 - SECTION IV: The property as defined by the legal descriptions in attachment
 "A" are hereby zoned Timberland Production Zone as provided by
 Chapter 17.12 of the Mariposa County Code in accordance with
 Government Code Section 51100 et seq.
 - SECTION V: The County shall cause to be filed with the County Recorder a

1	notice of timber production zone status, together with appro-
2	priate maps, and the Timberland Production Zone shall hereafter
3	include the property described herein in Attachment "A" on the
4	official zoning maps of Mariposa County pursuant to Section
5	17.06.010 of the Mariposa County Code, and shall be added to
6	said zone pursuant to Mariposa County Code Section 17.12.060.
7	SECTION VI: This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after
8	final passage pursuant to Government Code Section 25123.
