

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 579

2 AN URGENCY ORDINANCE REENACTING  
3 ORDINANCE No. 577 AMENDING  
4 THE P. E. R. S. CONTRACT

5 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors did enact Ordinance No. 577  
6 to amend the contract with the California Public Employees' Re-  
7 tirement System; and,

8 WHEREAS, said ordinance was enacted five days prematurely;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County  
10 does ordain as follows:

11 SECTION I: Ordinance No. 577 is hereby repealed and rescinded.

12 SECTION II: Section 2.72.030 of the Mariposa County Code is  
13 adopted to read as follows:

14 "2.72.030 Amendment to contract. An amendment to the  
15 contract between the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County  
16 and the Board of Administration, California Public Employees'  
17 Retirement System is hereby authorized, a copy of said amend-  
18 ment can be found on file in the clerk's office of the county  
19 located in the Courthouse and by reference is made a part of  
20 this section as though set out in full herein."

21 SECTION III: Section 2.72.040 of the Mariposa County Code is  
22 adopted to read as follows:

23 "2.72.040 Authority to execute amendment. The chairman  
24 of the board of supervisors is authorized, empowered, and  
25 directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the  
26 county."

27 SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect and become en-  
28 forceable immediately upon passage by at least a four-fifths (4/5)  
vote of the Board of Supervisors as an urgency measure pursuant to

1 Government Code Section 25123 as amended by Stats. 1981 Chapter 141.  
2 The facts constituting the necessity are: This amendment is neces-  
3 sary in order to implement provisions of a memorandum of under-  
4 standing resulting from collective bargaining with an employee  
5 organization.
