

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 598

2 PARKING REGULATIONS ADDED

3 THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Mariposa County does hereby
4 ordain as follows:

5 SECTION 1: Section 10.16.030 is added to the Mariposa
6 County Code to read as follows:

7 "10.16.030 Parking regulations within district.

8 Within vehicle parking district No. 1 it shall be unlawful:

9 A. To abandon or leave unattended any vehicle for a
10 period of more than forty-eight (48) hours within the areas
11 of said district designated for public parking.

12 B. To camp or reside in a vehicle for a continuous
13 period of more than forty-eight (48) hours within the areas
14 of said district designated for public parking.

15 C. To park in, or block with, an unoccupied vehicle
16 the loading zones within the district located in the follow-
17 ing locations:

18 1. The loading ramp area located along the south-
19 west boundary of the upper Sixth Street parking lot.

20 2. The loading zone located on the northeast
21 boundary of the Fifth Street parking lot immediately behind
22 the Hull House.

23 D. To park in handicapped parking areas within the
24 district, which shall be signed and marked according to law,
25 located as follows:

26 1. In the Fifth Street parking lot, one stall
27 on the northeast boundary at the north corner.

28 2. In the upper Sixth Street parking lot, two

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1 stalls along the northwest boundary, at the north corner."

2 SECTION II: Section 10.16.040 is added to the Mariposa
3 County Code to read as follows:

4 "10.16.040 Removal of vehicles not lawfully parked.

5 The district manager, the county road commissioner or any
6 duly authorized peace officer may remove or cause removal
7 of any vehicle parked in the public parking areas of the
8 district in violation of the regulations of this chapter,
9 and may store the vehicle or cause it to be stored at the
10 expense of the owner or operator thereof. Towing and
11 storage charges will be imposed by the person or firm who
12 tows or stores such vehicle."

13 SECTION III: Section 10.16.050 is added to the Mariposa
14 County Code to read as follows:

15 "10.16.050 Violation--penalty. Every violation of
16 the provisions of this chapter is an infraction punishable
17 as provided in Vehicle Code Section 42001 and Section
18 1.20.030 of this Code."

19 SECTION IV: Section 10.08.051 is added to the Mariposa
20 County Code to read as follows:

21 "10.08.051 Handicapped parking areas. The following
22 public parking areas are designated as handicapped parking,
23 for the exclusive use of persons bearing an authorized
24 handicapped sign, license plate, or sticker on their vehicle:

25 A. On the southwest side of Jones Street between Ninth
26 Street and Tenth Street, the parking space on each side of
27 the walkway entering the Courthouse from Jones Street and
28 immediately adjacent thereto--two spaces.

1 B. Designated handicapped parking spaces within
2 parking district No. 1 as described in Section 10.16.030.

3 C. On Sixth Street at the intersection of Highway 140,
4 the first stall on the southeast side in each direction from
5 the intersection, being two stalls, one northeast of the
6 intersection and one southwest of the intersection."

7 SECTION V. Section 10.08.052 is added to the Mariposa
8 County Code to read as follows:

9 "10.08.052 Courthouse parking. The following regula-
10 tions shall govern parking adjacent to the Mariposa County
11 Courthouse:

12 A. On the southeast side of Tenth Street between
13 Bullion Street and Jones Street, public parking shall be
14 permitted in diagonal stalls only.

15 B. On the southwest side of Jones Street between Ninth
16 Street and Tenth Street, parking is prohibited within
17 fifteen (15) feet of the fire hydrant located near the Jones
18 Street entrance to the Courthouse.

19 C. On the southwest side of Jones Street between Ninth
20 Street and Tenth Street, parking is prohibited in the two
21 stalls reserved for police parking only, one located as the
22 second stall northwest of the walkway entering the Courthouse
23 from Jones Street, and the other as the first stall southeast
24 of the fire hydrant zone."

25 SECTION VI: Section 10.08.053 is added to the Mariposa
26 County Code to read as follows:

27 "10.08.053 Parking in the Yosemite West Maintenance
28 District. It is unlawful to park any vehicle on the streets

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1 and roadways of the Yosemite West Maintenance District in
2 such a manner as to interfere with, obstruct or delay snow-
3 plow operations."


4 SECTION VII: Section 10.08.031 shall be added to the Mari-
5 posa County Code to read as follows:

6 "10.08.031 Camping and overnight parking. It shall be
7 unlawful to camp or reside in a vehicle for a continuous
8 period of more than forty-eight (48) hours on any public
9 street, road or highway in Mariposa County."


10 SECTION VIII: This ordinance shall become effective thirty
11 (30) days from the date of final passage pursuant to Government
12 Code Section 25123.
