

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 494

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE BY ADDING NEW PROVISION TO CHAPTER 10.04 - SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, does hereby ordain as follows:

Subsection 6 is hereby added to Section 10.04.010, subparagraph (a) of the Mariposa County Code as follows:

6. Darrah Road: From the intersection of Highway 49 south easterly on Darrah Road for one-half mile: 25 miles per hour.





1 NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADOPTION BY REFERENCE
2 OF A MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE

3 NOTICE is hereby given that on Tuesday, September 5,
4 1978, at 11 A.M., a public hearing will be held before the Board
5 of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, in
6 the Chambers of said Board in the Mariposa County Courthouse in
7 the Town of Mariposa, upon a proposal to adopt by reference a
8 Mariposa County Code together with secondary codes referred to
9 therein. The Mariposa County Code proposed to be adopted is a
10 codification of the general ordinances of the County of Mariposa,
11 and the secondary codes relates to standards for drinking and
12 culinary water and to improvement standards for minor subdivisions
13 divisions.

14 After the adoption of said Code, all general ordinances
15 of the County of Mariposa subsequently adopted will constitute
16 amendments to said Code. Three copies of the Code proposed to be
17 adopted and the secondary codes proposed to be adopted as a part
18 thereof hereinabove referred to are on file in the Office of the
19 County Clerk of the County of Mariposa in the Mariposa County
20 Courthouse and are open to inspection by any interested person.
21 At the time and place of the public hearing aforesaid, any
22 interested person may appear before the Board of Supervisors and
23 be heard on the question of the adoption of said Code and
24 secondary codes.
