## ORDINANCE NO 109

An ordinance to Amend Ordinance No 106 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the salaries, fees and expenses of County Officers, and providing for the salaries and number of deputies"

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 4 of Ordinance No 106 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Auditor.

The auditor may appoint a deputy auditor, whose salary shall be fifteen hundred dollars per annum, payable as the salaries of all county officials.

Section 8 of Ordinance No 106 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8, District Attorney.

The District Attorney of the County of Marinosa, State of California is hereby allowed a stenographer at a salary of six hundred dollars per annum, payable as the salaries of all county officials.

Section 9 of Ordinance No 107 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 9. Public Welfare Department.

One Director, \$1200 per annum payable in equal monthly installments.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict heretiwh are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after thirty days after its passage.
