ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES NOS. 111, 117 and 123, KNOWN AS THE "SALARY ORDINANCE OF 1943."

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 111, Section 20 of Ordinance No. 117 and Section 20 of Ordinance No. 123 are hereby amended to read as follows:

One county janitor shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors on the first Monday of January of each and every year for the term of one year at a salary of One Thousand Eight Hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars per annum, payable in equal monthly installments. *

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after thirty days after its passage.
