ORDINANCE NO. 132

An Ordinance To Amend Ordinance No. 123,
Known as the "Salary Ordinance of 1943."

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State
of California, do ordain as follows:

Paragraph 3 of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 123 is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"The recorder shall also be allowed extra help
for clerical and stenographic work when in his
opinion it is necessary. The salary paid for
such work shall not exceed Six (\$6.00) Dollars
per day or a total sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars per annum."

All ordinances now in force in the County of Mariposa
insofar as the same are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and
effect from and after thirty days after its passage. The Clerk
of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to
cause this ordinance to be published in the Mariposa Gazette, a
newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the
County of Mariposa, State of California, for at least one week
prior to fifteen days after its passage.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly passed and
