ORDINANCE NO. 139

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 97

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 97 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person who uses any of the roads of Mariposa County by driving any tractor which is not equipped with street plates over or on said roads shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

All ordinances now in effect in the County of Mariposa insofar as the same are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after thirty days after its passage. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to cause this ordinance to be published in the Mariposa Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Mariposa, State of California, for at least one week prior to fifteen days after its passage.
