ORDINANCE NO. 142

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

1. This ordinance shall be known as the Salary Ordinance of 1947.

2. The Board of Supervisors do hereby elect to consolidate the offices of the County Treasurer and County Tax Collector pursuant to the provisions of Section 4017 of the Political Code of California.

3. The salaries of the following County officers are hereby fixed as follows:

(a) Assessor	\$2,700.00 per annum
(b) County Clerk	\$2,700.00 " "
(c) Recorder	\$1,500.00 " "
(d) Sheriff	\$3,800.00 " "
(e) Treasurer and Tax Collector	\$2,700.00 " "
(After 12M January 8, 1951)	
(f) Tax Collector	\$2,400.00 " "
(Until 12M January 8, 1951)	
(g) Treasurer	\$2,400.00 " "
(Until 12M January 8, 1951)	
(h) Deputy Auditor	\$2,100.00 " "

The salary of all other County officers and employees, not subject to the jurisdiction of the Legislature, shall be fixed by the Board of Supervisors by resolution.

4. The salaries of the following Township officers are hereby fixed as follows:

5. The following County and Township officers are hereby authorized to retain for their own personal use fees as follows:

- (a) Clerk All fees connected with naturalization matters pending in the Superior Court.
- (b) Coroner All fees allowed by law.
- (c) Public Administrator All fees allowed by law.

- 1 (d) Recorder All fees collected for filing and  
2 recording Proofs of Labor and No-  
3 tices of Location of Mining Claims;  
4 one half of all other fees in excess  
5 of \$100.00 collected in any one month.
- 6 (e) Sheriff All fees and mileage for the service  
7 of papers in civil cases; all mileage  
8 for service of papers issued by  
9 Courts outside this County.
- 10 (f) Surveyor All fees allowed by law.
- 11 (g) Treasurer All commissions on inheritance and  
12 transfer taxes; all fees for keeping  
13 funds deposited by the Public Ad-  
14 ministrator.
- 15 (h) Constables All mileage and fees for the service  
16 of papers issued by any Court in  
17 civil cases; mileage for every mile  
18 actually travelled in making arrests  
19 and in taking persons from the place  
20 of arrest to Court or the County  
21 Jail; \$8.00 for summoning a jury for  
22 the trial of a criminal case.

23 Except as herein otherwise provided, all fees and commissions now or here-  
24 after provided by law to be paid to any County or Township officer, in any  
25 capacity whatsoever, shall be paid into the County Treasury. Until such County  
26 or Township officer or employee shall pay into the County Treasury such fees  
27 and commissions as are herein required to be so paid, he shall receive no salary  
28 from the County.

29 6. Where any officer or employee of the County of Mariposa is obliged in  
30 the discharge of his duties to travel within or without the County of Mariposa,  
31 unless a specific allowance for such travel and incidental expenses is specifi-  
32 cally provided, he shall receive the sum of ten (10) cents per mile for each  
33 mile traveled in the County or outside the County in the discharge of his of-  
34 ficial duties in full for the use of his own vehicle used in such travel or  
35 for the use of a vehicle hired or rented and used in the discharge of his offi-  
36 cial duties. If such travel be by any public conveyance, he shall be allowed  
37 the actual cost of transportation. Where a motor vehicle is supplied by the  
38 County and the cost of operation and upkeep thereof paid by the County, no al-  
39 lowance for mileage shall be paid to or received by any officer or employee but  
40 only the actual cost of maintenance while traveling.

1           7. The salaries and fees provided for herein or by resolution of the Board  
2 of Supervisors shall be in full for all official services performed, including  
3 those duties performed in an ex-officio capacity.

4           8. The number, method of appointment, tenure, and compensation of all  
5 deputies, assistants and employees of the County not provided for herein, shall  
6 be fixed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

7           9. The salaries of all County and Township officers and employees shall  
8 be paid monthly out of the County Treasury on the last day of each month upon  
9 warrant drawn by the County Auditor.

10          10. Ordinances Numbered 106, 107, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 116, 117,  
11 118, 122, 123, 124, 127, 129, 132, 134, 135, 136, 138 and 140, together with  
12 any part of any other ordinance, resolution or order in conflict herewith, are  
13 hereby repealed.

14          11. This ordinance shall take effect August 1, 1947.
