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DESIGN OF THE ATLAS

The Mariposa Country First Responder Road Atlas includes 139 map grids covering the County of Mariposa. The scale of these map grids are 1:24,000. Additionally there are 127 detail areas with scale varying from 1:3,000, 1:6,000, and 1:12,000. Map scale is read (for example) by 1:20,000 = one unit of measure on the map represents 20,000 units of the same measurement on the ground.

ORIENTATION

The sides of the map grids are aligned with true north/south. The tops and bottoms run true east/west. When using a compass to orient maps to an actual field location, consider that magnetic north may be different from true north.
