RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

The Board authorize the chair to sign the Challenge Grant Applications/Assurances in order that Mariposa County receive Challenge Grant funds for fiscal year 1989-90.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Since 1986 Mariposa County has been receiving Challenge Grant Funds from the Office of Child Abuse Prevention. Challenge Grant funds are federal funds allocated to the State for child abuse and neglect prevention activities. In California, Challenge Grant funds are added to the Children's Trust Fund. Last year Mariposa County received \$27,347.00. This year's allocation will most likely be a similar amount. Our allocation will be received once the State receives the signed applications/assurances.

The Child Abuse Prevention Coordinating Council recommends to the Board of Supervisors how these funds are spent. In the past, funds have been used for respite care for at-risk families, training, training materials, video equipment, teen task force activities, foster parent training, library books for the public library, etc.

These funds are a valuable resource for providing child abuse prevention activities for children and the community. The Child Abuse Prevention Council will be formulating a plan for expenditures of the Challenge Grant Funds and returning to the Board for approval in May 1990.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Mariposa County will not receive an allocation for the program year 1989-90.
