BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Last month, the Board directed the Health Officer to proceed with negotiations with Kent Stoel who offered to build an animal impound facility. Mr. Stoel has since had to withdraw his offer. Dr. Ritter cannot provide either impound or professional services to the County at this time. Dr. Rosebrock has offered to provide both for a sh time (up to two years) provided the County begins the process to build a County pound, and that the pound is operational no later than two years from now.

Prices for daily impound, emergency treatment, and professional services are higher than last year and reflect, according to Dr. Rosebrock, his usual and customary fees.
