RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Recognize the UFCW Local 1288 Credit Union as an official banking institution in order to allow the Auditor to make payroll deductions from employee's paychecks to the UFCW Credit Union.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Resolution 79-15 adopted January 23, 1979, allowed the Auditor to make payroll deductions from Mariposa County employee's paychecks and forward requested amount to the Yosemite Credit Union. Since the Employees Assoc. has affiliated with SEIU, all members now eligible to join UFCW Credit Union. If approved, members of the Emp. Assoc. will have a lot more banking services available to them.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Employees have only 1 credit union available to them which has very limited services, and employees only able to deposit entire paycheck through the Auditor rather than having a requested amount deducted.
