

MARIPOSA COUNTY
RESOLUTION 90- 558

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE PROPOSED MARIPOSA ROADSIDE REST AND RECREATION AREA at Jessie Street and Coakley Circle.

WHEREAS, a need has been identified for a rest area in the Town of Mariposa for visitors enroute to Yosemite and other destinations; and,

WHEREAS, a continuous left turn lane to be constructed next year within the Town will increase the need for shade, green space, and parking that can be provided by this rest area; and,

WHEREAS, Mariposa County has purchased property suitable for this purpose at the corner of Jessie Street and Coakley Circle, adjacent to the History Center; and,

WHEREAS, a rest and recreation center will complement the existing History Center and Museum; and,

WHEREAS, a rest area will allow visitor access to the Mariposa Creek Project, California State Mineral Exhibit, Courthouse, and other nearby attractions in the community; and,

WHEREAS, Mariposa County has the authority to construct this rest and recreation area; and,

WHEREAS, Mariposa County has the resources, experience, and commitment to maintain this rest and recreation area as a County Park, once constructed; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Program makes funds available for projects that mitigate the effects of related transportation facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Mariposa County proposes to construct the Mariposa Roadside Rest and Recreation

Area at the Coakley Circle, providing state funding becomes available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mariposa County will maintain the completed Mariposa Roadside Rest and Recreation Area as a County Park.
