

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 90-567

A RESOLUTION OF CONGRATULATIONS IN THE CULMINATION
OF BOWER CAVE BECOMING PUBLIC LAND

WHEREAS, Bower Cave is a significant historical landmark in Mariposa County; and

WHEREAS, a land for land exchange was made for the purpose of improving national forest landownership; and

WHEREAS, this land contains the reknowned Bower Cave, as well as an historic residence, meadows, woodlands and ponds which will make a magnificent addition to the National Forest System; and

WHEREAS, this exchange ensures the preservation of significant riparian and meadow values as well as renewed public access and the rehabilitation of Bower Cave; and

WHEREAS, this exchange will provide an environmental and social asset to Mariposa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Board commemorates the celebration and culmination of the Bower Cave land exchange.


