WEED ABATEMENT OWNER CONTROL AGREEMENT

This agreement is valid for as long as the property is owned by the Property Owner(s) unless otherwise noted.

The Property owner(s) agree to control roadside weeds at least 4 feet wide along the entire length of their property frontage adjacent to a County maintained road. The weed abatement implemented by property owner(s) shall limit growth to no more than 6 inches in height and shall not till the soil. The weed abatement shall not impact safe use of the road by others and may be inspected by Mariposa County Public Works to ensure management is being performed satisfactorily. In consideration of the foregoing, the Public Works Weed Abatement Program will specifically exclude the property limits from County initiated Weed Abatement practices. Exempt from this agreement is the control of such weeds identified as "Toxic/Noxious/Invasive" in accordance with California Weed Laws and also those considered detrimental to agricultural commodities as identified by the County Agricultural Commissioner. This nuisance vegetation is subject to eradication upon identification without notification. This agreement also does not cover brush and/or tree control as remains the responsibility of Public Works.

Upon receipt of this signed agreement, Public works will provide the Property Owner(s) an agreement acknowledgement, signed copy of the agreement and a diagram that shows the limits of their property adjacent to the County maintained road(s). Before and during application, a licensed and bonded experienced contractor will locate and have access to GPS coordinates of excluded properties. The Property Owner(s) may attach signs at property boundaries on County roads to indicate the limits of property boundaries as long as the signs do not impede regular traffic activity.

Property Owner(s) that do not comply with the contractual agreement after a reasonable number of attempts on behalf of Mariposa County, may be subject to nullification of the agreement in writing.

The Property Owner(s) shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Mariposa, the Department of Public Works, its employees and agents of all claims, demands, actions and requests whatsoever that may arise directly or indirectly from carrying out of this agreement.
